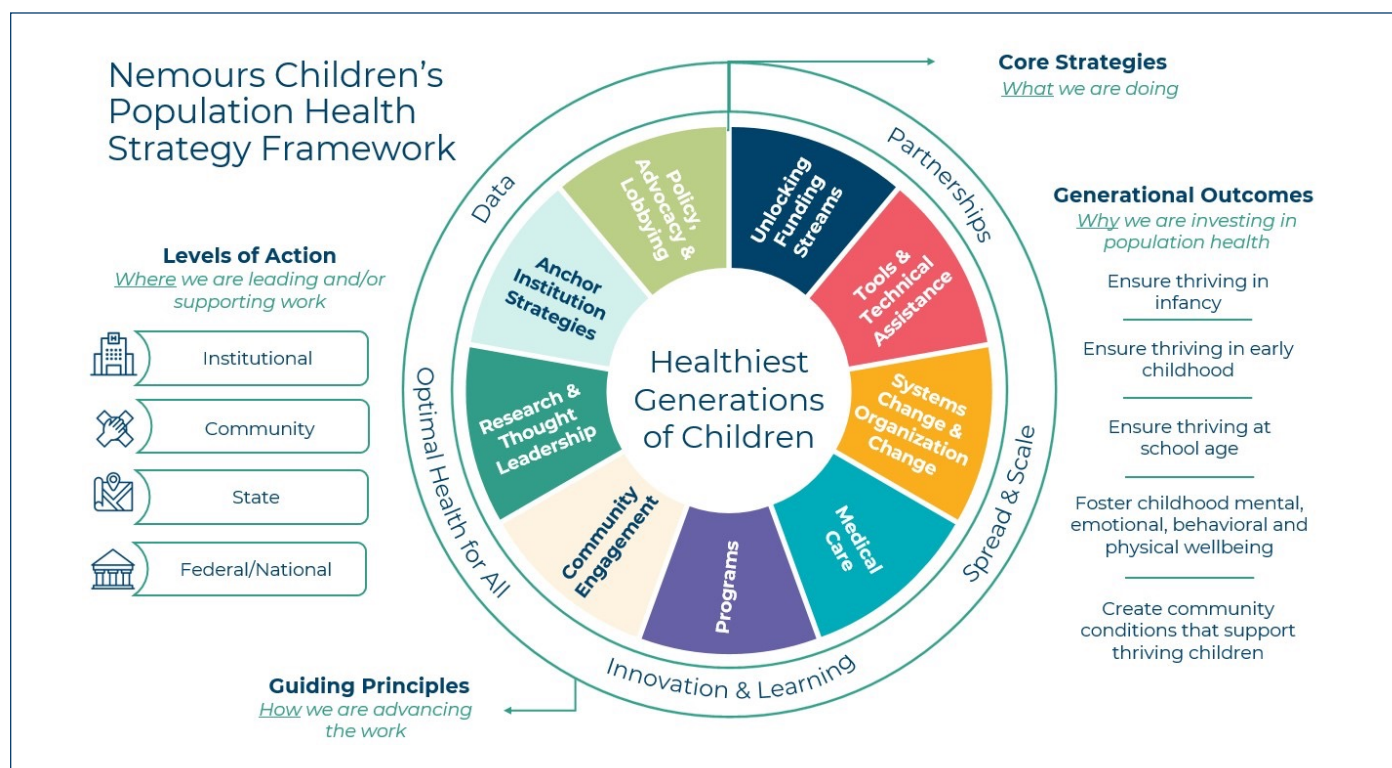


Advancing Population Health to Improve Children's Health: Summary
