## **Program Objectives**

The practicum at Nemours Children's Health, Florida is designed to provide child life students with a primarily observational experience, in addition to hands-on opportunities when appropriate, ultimately serving as preparation for clinical child life internships. Our practicum builds on the foundation of child development and theory as well as teaches students the core competencies of clinical child life practice. This includes how to assess patients and families' psychosocial and developmental needs, plan therapeutic interventions, and utilize evidenced-based practice to influence multidisciplinary care. The practicum student will be supervised by a Certified Child Life Specialist that has a minimum of 2000 paid hours of experience.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

1. Applicants must be affiliated or enrolled at a university.
2. Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher in their major.
3. Applicants are required to have completed a minimum of three of the required ACLP Courses when applying, including a Child Development course.
4. Applicants must have completed a total of **100 hours** of verifiable fieldwork experience with children in a structured environment (applicable descriptions found below)
  - a. Hospital setting
  - b. Camp setting
  - c. Bereavement/Grief center
  - d. Nurseries, daycare, school programs
  - e. Care of children at home, such as being a nanny/babysitting or caring for one's own children **does not count** toward this requirement
5. Two letters of recommendation
  - a. One letter must be from an academic source
  - b. One letter from someone who can speak to your experience with children upon observations (no relatives or friends)

## Practicum Application Checklist

To be considered for placement in the practicum program, you must include the following with your application. Applications not containing the following components will be considered incomplete. Incomplete and late applications will not be reviewed.

- Completed and signed practicum application postmarked by the stated application deadline.

- Components of this application must be typed and not handwritten.
- Academic transcripts from all colleges or universities attended (unofficial copies accepted).
- Current Professional Resume.
- **3 experiences** working with children in diverse settings, submitted via experience forms
- Practicum Questionnaire.
- Two letters of recommendation (Academic/Observation).
