Nemours is affiliated with Wolfson Children's Hospital, the only tertiary referral children's hospital in the region. Wolfson is a Pediatric Trauma Center, and the emergency department is staffed entirely by fellowship-trained pediatric emergency medicine physicians.

We educate residents from the University of Florida and the Mayo Clinic. Our fellow participates directly in resident education and can develop clinical and surgical skills in a setting that allows for independent judgment, while maintaining appropriate supervision.

TYPICAL SCHEDULE

- Fellows begin the academic year by spending one month with each attending.
- During the remainder of the year, we tailor the experience to the fellow's needs, based on interests, needed skills and anticipated future practice type.
- Fellows typically begin the year by participating in home call in the resident call schedule for one month.
- After the first month, they transition to our attending call schedule, where they will have privileges to care for patients at Wolfson Children's Hospital and teach residents.
- Attending call coverage is one week at a time, and will typically occur once every six weeks.
- The weekly schedule typically includes daily rounding and academic sessions at 7 a.m., followed by clinical duties with the assigned teaching attending.
- Conferences include: Preoperative Indications, Postoperative Conference, Interesting Cases, Core Curriculum, Grand Rounds, SMART Rounds (NM patients), Neurosurgery-Orthopedic Spine, Nemours Cross-Campus Spine Conference, Journal Club
